Project Title	Implementation of the Technical Support Facility under the Carbon Market Initiative

Project Background	<p>The Asian Development Bank is implementing the Carbon Market Initiative (CMI) through its Regional and Sustainable Development Department (RSDD) since the beginning of 2007. CMI has three components: (i) the Asia Pacific Carbon Fund (APCF) for providing upfront carbon financing; (ii) the Technical Support Facility (TSF) for providing technical CDM support and (iii) the Credit Marketing Facility (CMF) for providing carbon credit marketing support to the developing member countries. TSF has identified several projects from ADB's portfolio that are eligible under the Clean Development Mechanism (CDM) under the Kyoto Protocol. The present TSF team is providing technical support to over 30 projects with funding from the Japan Special Fund.</p> <p>ADB is committed to providing support to greenhouse gas (GHG) mitigation projects under its financing portfolio on a continual basis and approved a three-year regional technical assistance.</p>
Projective Objective	<p>Winrock is working as a national CDM Expert for this project</p> <p>The overall objective was to prepare documents required for registration of CDM projects from Nepal and capacity building of domestic project developers.</p>
Activities/Components	<p>(i) Identify potential projects in the energy, transport, urban, and other sectors that may qualify for CDM and are suitable for ADB financing;</p> <p>(ii) Identify CDM project opportunities from ADB's lending and non-lending pipelines and assess their CDM potential;</p> <p>(iii) Manage the process of registration and monitoring of the identified CDM projects through the following steps:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Study information on the identified CDM eligible projects provided by the operations departments and prepare a Desktop Screening Report (DSR) for review by the Team Leader; b. Based on the feedback from Team Leader, prepare a CDM Assessment Report (CAR); c. Support the TSF Team for new CDM methodology design, as necessary; d. On receiving concurrence from ADB and in cooperation with the project developer, prepare the Project Design Document (PDD), Project Concept Note (PCN) and any other documents necessary for host country clearance, carry out local stakeholder consultations and if required prepare new baseline/monitoring methodology in line with the standard format approved by the CDM Executive Board. This also involves translation of material necessary to develop PDD, as well as communication with local entities; and e. After inputs from Team Leader, facilitate the processes of host

	<p>country approval, validation by Designated Operational Entity (DOE) and registration.</p> <p>(iv) Assist the Executing Agency (EA) in setting the monitoring plan in action, preparing the monitoring report and facilitating initial and periodic verification of the project (for the first verification period);</p> <p>(v) Assist the team in organizing and participate in capacity-building workshops for project developers, project sponsors, and government institutions in the country of operation.</p> <p>(vi) Support the Team Leader on knowledge management related to policy, market and technology on climate change mitigation in the country of operation</p>
